### DARRELL HOLT CHALLENGE TEAMS ROLL-OFFS RULES, PARTICIPANT INFORMATION and NOMINATION FORM

#### ELIGIBILITY

Nomination is open to all bowlers meeting the following eligibility criteria. For both tournaments:

- 1. Be resident in the ACT Holt Challenge Zone
- 2. Have current 2025 TBA membership;
- 3. Be financial members of the ACT Holt Challenge Inc.;
- 4. Have attained, or will attain, 18 years of age on, or prior to, the first day of the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival in ACT; and.
- 5. Have competed in at least eight (8) weeks of league competition: bowling a minimum of twentyfour (24) games in a single league in a registered centre, within the ACT Holt Challenge Zone in 2024.

For the <u>Restricted</u> Challenge Tournament: Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 184 Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 174 For the <u>Classic</u> Challenge Tournament: Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 199 Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 195

#### AVERAGE

Please list all leagues during 2024. This includes ALL leagues, touring leagues and leagues finishing midyear, end of year or any unfinished league with 24 games or more bowled.

The competitor must not have any league average, including touring leagues, over a minimum of 24 games at the end of any league season or in any current season within the preceding year exceeding the maximum averages as listed above.

#### HANDICAP

Handicap will be 100% of the difference between bowler average and 200 and will be applied to bowler's scores when used towards the Restricted Team.

#### SMOKING AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Smoking and the consumption of alcohol are prohibited whilst the trials are in progress. From the first ball rolled in practice to the last ball bowled for each day.

#### **BOWLING ATTIRE**

All bowlers are required to wear a collared shirt. Neat and tidy bowling attire is acceptable; NO jeans, active wear, or hats to be worn whilst competing. The Tournament Committee will decide on acceptable attire.

#### DISPUTES

Any dispute or complaint must be lodged with the Tournament Director within fifteen (15) minutes of the alleged infringement.

#### **PLAYER EXPECTATIONS**

All Bowlers will sign a Code of Conduct form upon acceptance of making any Team. All Team members will be required to attend Team Dinners held the night before the challenges, and the following 2 nights of their respective Representative Team if it can be arranged. (Managers Responsibility) Team accommodation will only be arranged by the ACT Holt Committee on request, and this must be done within 14 days following Roll Offs. (Bowlers can arrange their own independently). Training sessions will be advised in writing via email or HOLT ACT Face Book Page.

#### **GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION**

All TBA Tournament Rules & Regulations apply.

All Holt Challenge specific rules apply, and where there is a conflict between TBA and Holt rules, the Holt rules will have precedence.

Any matters not covered in the conditions will be decided by the Tournament Committee

#### \*No refunds will be paid

- If a team vacancy arises, the next available bowler who participated in the roll-offs will fill the spot. If there is no one available, the Committee will apply to the National Holt Committee for a draft bowler from another state.
- Depending on the outcome of fundraising throughout the year, individual bowlers will be required to pay all expenses remaining.
- Nomination fee of \$50.00 must accompany Nomination Roll Off Form, plus \$15 Holt membership (if not already paid)
- Roll-Off cost is \$130 (Not including membership fees) and is to be paid at or before check-in prior to commencement of day 1.

Check in closes to all bowlers 1/2 hour before commencement of roll off.

- DAY 1 Saturday March 1<sup>st</sup> 7 GAMES to be held at Zone Bowling Tuggeranong, with Check in @12.30pm for 1.00pm start.
- DAY 2 Sunday March 2<sup>nd</sup> 7 GAMES to be held at Tuggeranong, with Check in @9.00am for 9.30am start.

#### **SELECTION OF TEAMS**

At the completion of the fourteen (14) games, the tournament committee will announce both the restricted and classic challenge teams, based upon the following:

#### DARRELL HOLT RESTRICTED CHALLENGE TEAM

The top seven (7) male, and top seven (7) female bowlers, based on total pinfall with handicap will be declared the Darrell Holt Restricted Teams for 2025.

In the event of a tie for the final position in either division, a one game playoff will be played to determine the final place.

Handicap will be applied to the playoff game, as normal.

#### DARRELL HOLT MIXED CLASSIC CHALLENGE TEAM

The top four (4) male, and top three (3) female bowlers, based on total scratch score only, will be declared the Darrell Holt Classic Challenge Teams for 2025.

In the event of a tie for the final position in either division, a one game playoff will be played to determine the final place.

#### **REPRESENTATION at TROPHY EVENTS**

The top qualifier in each team, male and female, will earn the right to represent the state at the relevant Masters' events during the 2025 Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival.

#### THE HOLT TENPIN BOWLING CARNIVAL

The 2025 Holt Carnival will be held at **SUPERBOWL, 12 Dugdale Street, WARWICK, WA** from August 9<sup>th</sup> to August 22<sup>nd</sup> 2025. (Presentation Dinner details will be advised once known).

All bowlers who were not successful in making the teams are welcome to nominate for the draft to fill vacancies in other state teams or attend the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival to participate in the other events. Further information can be found at <u>www.holtchallenge.org.au</u>

#### **ACCOMMODATION:**

Accommodation will be the responsibility of the bowlers that make the Classic and/or Restricted Teams. Those that require advice or assistance in locating accommodation can approach the Committee.

\*It is an expectation that all Classic Teams members are in their respective accommodation on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2025 and the Restricted Team by 12 Noon on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025.

This will allow a more efficient arrangement of squad times.

#### **COSTS AND DEPOSITS**

The following information is applicable to members of all teams. In the case where a bowler makes both teams, the following should be applied for both teams (in effect, the amounts are doubled for bowlers in both teams) so that both teams may offset their preliminary costs. You can make payments in instalments if you wish to account listed below.

Costs for challenge teams include All Events entries, uniforms, lineage, dinner tickets and the Tournament Registration Fee, where applicable. The costs must be paid as per the following payment schedule:

- \$100 deposit, within fourteen (14) days of the conclusion of the roll off (16<sup>th</sup> March 2025), and
- \$250 payment on or before 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

These payments are required for all bowlers and team officials, irrespective of any fundraising that bowlers may have participated in.
