Holt Challenge Bowler Safety Policy

Health and Safety is a high priority for all officials, bowlers, volunteers and spectators attending the Holt Challenges and Tenpin Bowling Carnival. Every effort has been made to ensure the health and safety of all officials, bowlers, volunteers and spectators. Holt Challenge Inc. and host venue accept no liability for personal injury or loss or damage to any personal property of bowlers, officials, spectators and volunteers while at the bowling venue. The following rules and regulations must be followed to ensure the well-being of all people entering the bowling Centre.

HEALTH & SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- There is to be no running inside the Centre.
- There is to be no smoking inside the Centre. Smoking is be in designated outside areas and a distance from any entry as per the relevant state government or authority.
- Food and drinks may only be consumed in the areas so designated by the proprietor.
- Bowlers, officials and spectators may only access areas so designated by the proprietor. There is to be no access to *Back of House* or *Staff Only* areas.
- There are changes to floor coverings within the Centre and patrons are required to observe these changes when walking through the Centre.
- Care must be taken when on stairways. There is to be no running on any Centre stairways, including temporary grandstand stairways.
- Only bowlers and designated officials are permitted in the competitor's area.
- There is to be no standing on seats in the spectator grandstand or general spectator areas.
- Spillages in either general areas or in washrooms must be reported immediately to Centre staff.
- Care must be taken in car park areas. Patrons are requested to only walk in designated pedestrian zones.
- Bowlers are requested to store equipment in the areas so designated. Any items of value should be left with a responsible person. Competitors bowling bags may be stored in the provided ball paddock when not bowling. Bowling bags are to be stored away from all traffic areas whilst bowling, preferably under the grandstand. BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SECURITY OF THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT AND BELONGINGS.
- Bowlers, officials, volunteers and spectators must not block Centre entrances and exits with personal belongings and/or equipment
- In the event of an evacuation of the Centre, patrons are required to follow directions of the Centre staff at all times.
- In the event of an injury or illness, Team officials and the Centre proprietor must be advised immediately and appropriate medical attention will be sought. Contact details for medical assistance are posted throughout the Centre.
